**PERPENDICULAR (GB)**, won Prince of Wales's Stakes, Royal Ascot, Gr.2,  
 P. Zino Davidoff-P. der Deutschen Einheit, Hoppegarten, Gr.3, R.O.A.  
 Foundation Stakes, Goodwood, L., third in G. Mercedes Benz-Bayerisches  
 Zuchtrennen, Munich, Gr.1 and William Hill Dante Stakes, York, Gr.2; sire.
