 Nora Yo Ya, ran once; dam of YO YA (IRE), 4 races at 2 and 3 years, 2004 in Italy and placed 15 times; grandam of RATIO (GB), 5 races including Dubai International Airport World Trophy, Newbury, Gr.3.

 Silk Sari (BRZ), unraced; dam of LE CORBOUSIER (BRZ), won Grande Premio Onze de Julho, Gavea, Gr.2.
