#### 1st Dam

**BOLD DIFFERENCE**, won 3 races at 2 and 3 years and £5,197 including Crusaders Horn Handicap, Beverley, placed 3 times including second in Boothferry Park Nursery Handicap, Beverley; also placed fourth 3 times;  
dam of 4 runners and 5 foals of racing age viz-  
Never Cried Wolf (GB) (2001 g. by Wolfhound (USA)), ran a few times at 3 years, 2004.

#### 2nd Dam

**SUBTLE QUEEN**, unplaced at 3 years;  
dam of three winners from 6 runners and 8 foals of racing age viz-  
**RUN FOR FRED**, placed 3 times at 3 and 5 years; also won 4 races at 6 years in Belgium and £5,049.

**BOLD GAMBLE**, won 3 races at 2 and 3 years; also placed twice over hurdles.  
Bull's Lad, placed twice at 2 years; also placed twice over hurdles.

**ENDLESS QUESTIONS**, ran a few times at 3 years;  
dam of two winners from 5 runners and 8 foals of racing age viz-  
**MINI JET**, won 17 races in Belgium.  
**ON AND ON**, won 9 races in Belgium.  
Ques Any, placed once at 2 years.  
Subtle Answer, unraced; dam of winners.  
**BOLD ANSWER**, won 1 race at 3 years and placed twice; also 1 race over hurdles and placed twice and placed once over fences.  
**CLEARWAY**, won 1 race at 2 years and placed once.
