*BALLOTADE* (GB) (1999 f. by Robellino (USA)), won 5 races at 5 and 6 years, 2005 in Germany and Holland and £10,269 and placed 18 times.

*TAKE A MILE* (IRE) (2002 g. by Inchinor (GB)), won 1 race at 3 years, 2005 and placed 3 times; also won 1 race over hurdles and £7,594 and placed 5 times.
