

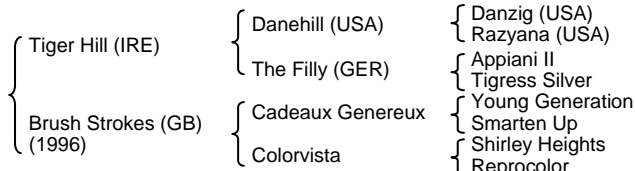

BELLA COLORA, won 4 races at home and in France including Prix de l'Opera, Longchamp, Gr.2, third in 1000 Guineas, Newmarket, Gr.1; dam of winners.

STAGECRAFT, Champion older horse in Europe in 1991 (9.5-11 f.), won Prince of Wales's Stakes, Ascot, Gr.2, second in Eclipse Stakes; sire.

MULLINS BAY (GB), won Strensall Stakes, York, Gr.3.

HYABELLA (GB), won Ben Marshall Stakes, Newmarket, L.; grandam of FRANCE (GB), won EBF Tetrarch Stakes, Curragh, Gr.3, second in Irish 2000 Guineas, Curragh, Gr.1; sire, ALESSANDRO VOLTA (GB), 2 races to 2008 viz Derby Trial, Lingfield Park, Gr.3, placed 3 times.
