STAN'S COOL CAT (IRE), won 1 race at 2 years, 2008, placed 3 times.

BERMUDA GRASS (IRE), won 3 races at 2 and 3 years in France including P. Peintre Celebre Criterium de l'Ouest, Craon, L., placed twice.
