Cresta Gold (GB) (2003 f. by Halling (USA)), won 2 races at 3 years and £40,539 and placed 8 times including second in VC Bet Aphrodite Stakes, Newmarket, L., third in Unicorn Homes Noel Murless Stakes, Newmarket, L.
