Lady Superior (GB) (2003 f. by Superior Premium (GB)), placed once at 2 years, died at 3.

SPRING (NZ), winner in New Zealand; dam of DAFFODIL (NZ), won Patinack Farm AJC Oaks, Randwick, Gr.1 and New Zealand Bloodstock 1000 Guineas, Riccarton Park, Gr.1.

Charlotte Dundas (GB), placed once at 3 years; dam of winners.

BAND GIPSY (USA), won Grande Premio Presidente da Republica, Gavea, Gr.1.

Laugharne, ran once at 2 years; dam of winners.

Power Lake (GB), winner at home and in Italy, second in Flying Childers Stakes, Doncaster, Gr.2.
