**AUNT HESTER (IRE)**, won 1 race at 2 years and placed 3 times;

dam of **six winners** from 9 runners and 10 foals of racing age viz-

**Funny Valentine (IRE)** (g. by Cadeaux Geneureux), won 2 races at 3 years and placed 5 times including third in King's Stand Stakes, Royal Ascot, **Gr.2**.

Thomson Memorial Stakes, Wanganui, **L.**; grandam of **Zennista (NZ)**, won 2 races at 2 and 3 years, 2010/2011 in New Zealand, placed second in Wellfield New Zealand Oaks, Trentham, **Gr.1**.

Falcons Fire (NZ), placed 6 times in New Zealand; grandam of **Poetic Music (NZ)**, won 4 races in New Zealand, placed third in Oceanz Seafood Northland Breeders' Stakes, Ruakaka, **L.**
