VALERIAN (IRE), won 1 race at 3 years and placed once; also won 5 races at 4 and 5 years, 2005 in Singapore and £42,590.

SHE ROCKS (IRE), won 1 race at 2 years and £8259 and placed twice; also won 4 races at 3 to 5 years in U.S.A. and £88,910 and placed 7 times.

LOUP SAUVAGE (USA), Champion older horse in Europe in 1998 (9.5-10.5f.), won Prix d'Ispahan, Longchamp, Gr.1, placed second in Champion Stakes, Newmarket, Gr.1, Poule d'Essai des Poulains, Gr.1, third in Irish Derby, Curragh, Gr.1 and Dubai World Cup, Nad Al Sheba, Gr.1; sire.

LOUP SOLITAIRE (USA), Champion 2yo colt in France in 1995, won Grand Criterium, Longchamp, Gr.1, second in Prix Lupin, Longchamp, Gr.1; sire.

LOUVE (USA), 2 races at 3 years in France including Prix de Flore, Saint-Cloud, Gr.3; dam of *LOUVE ROYALE (IRE)*, 3 races at 3 and 5 years, 2006 in France and U.S.A. including Top Corsage Handicap, Churchill Downs, placed second in Bewitch Stakes, Keeneland, Gr.3.

L'ILE DU REVE (USA), won 2 races at 3 years including Cheshire Oaks, Gr.3; grandam of *PREMIER COLLECTION (IND)*, won Idar Gold Trophy, Pune, L. *Louve Bleue (USA)*, won 2 races at 3 and 4 years in France and U.S.A. and placed second in Prix Saint-Alary, Longchamp, Gr.1; dam of winners.

LOUVE MYSTERIEUSE (USA), won Prix Madame Jean Couturie, Vichy, L. *Louve Romaine (USA)*, won 1 race at 3 years in France and placed 3 times viz third in Prix de Diane Hermes, Chantilly, Gr.1, Prix Saint-Alary, Longchamp, Gr.1 and Prix Coronation, Saint-Cloud, L.; dam of winners.
