SQUADRON LEADER (USA), won 2 races in U.S.A. including Jim Bowie Stakes, Dueling Grounds, L.; sire in U.S.A.

RIVER PRINCE (USA), won 1 race at 3 years viz Herbertstown Stakes, Phoenix Park, L., placed 3 times including third in Stackallen Stakes, Phoenix Park, L.; sire.
