**JIBE (USA)**, won 2 races at 2 and 3 years including Newbury Fillies' Trial Stakes, Newbury, **L.**, placed second in Fillies' Mile Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.1**; dam of a winner.

**Deploy**, won 2 races at 3 years, second in Irish Derby, Curragh, **Gr.1**; sire.

**Totality (GB)**, won 1 race at 3 years, placed second in Lancashire Oaks, Haydock Park, **Gr.3** and Leicester Mercury Stakes, Leicester, **L.**; dam of winners.
