SHIMAH (USA), Jt Champion 2yr old filly in Ireland in 2008, **won** 2 races at 2 years and £78,254 including Saoire Stakes, Curragh, **L.**, placed once viz second in Moygliare Stud Stakes, Curragh, **Gr.1**, from only 4 starts;

dam of **four winners** from 6 runners and 7 foals of racing age viz-

MUSHIR (GB) (c. by Oasis Dream (GB)), won 6 races at home and in U.A.E. and £116,494 including Rockingham Stakes, York, **L.**, placed second in CSP European Free Handicap, Newmarket, **L.**, Jebel Ali Sprint, Jebel Ali, **L.** and third in City Plate, Chester, **L.**

ESTIKHRAAJ (GB), won 7 races at 3, 5 and 6 years at home and in Australia and £214,201.

MOGHAMARAH (GB), won 1 race at 2 years and £14,401 and placed twice, all her starts.

WALAYEF (USA), won 3 races at 2 and 3 years including Athasi Stakes, Curragh, **Gr.3** and Round Tower Stakes, Curragh, **L.**, placed once, from only 5 starts; dam of winners.

Jamaayel (GB), 2 races at 2 years and placed 3 times including second in New Tote Sports Lounge Loughbrown Stakes, Curragh, **L.**; dam of **Rathaath (IRE)**, 3 races at 2 and 3 years and placed once viz third in Albert Bartlett Rous Stakes, Ascot, **L.**

REYAADA (GB), 1 race at 2 years; dam of **Mohaayed (GB)**, 2 races at 2 and 3 years and placed 3 times including third in Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial Stakes, Leopardstown, **L.**; also 4 races over hurdles including County Handicap Hurdle, Cheltenham and Belfair Racing Welfare Handicap Hurdle, Ascot, placed 7 times.

ULFAH (USA), won 4 races at 2 and 3 years including Belgrave Stakes, Curragh, **L.** and EBF Sweet Mimosa Stakes, Leopardstown, **L.**, placed twice; dam of winners.

The next dam **MUHBUBH (USA)**, **won** 2 races at 2 years including Princess Margaret Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.3**, placed 3 times including second in The Update Lowther Stakes, York, **Gr.2**;

KAYRAWAN (USA), won 6 races at 2 and 4 years at home, in U.A.E. and in U.S.A. including Tom Fool Stakes, Belmont Park, **Gr.2**; sire.

Amani (USA), won 2 races at 2 years and placed 5 times including third in Shadwell Stud Firth of Clyde Stakes, Ayr, **L.**; dam of winners.

BALAABEL (USA), won 1 race at 3 years, placed 7 times, from only 9 starts; dam of winners.

SAYEDAH (IRE), 1 race at 2 years viz Owen Brown Rockfel Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.2**; dam of **A LITTLE BIT ME (USA)**, won Unbridled Sidney Stakes, Churchill Downs and second in Spendthrift Ladies Sprint Stakes, Kentucky Downs, **Gr.3**.

ALSHARQ (IRE), 1 race at 3 years; dam of **SANDREAMER (IRE)**, 2 races at 2 years at home and in Italy including Premio Eupilii, Milan, **L.**, second in Juddmonte Princess Margaret Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.3**.

MARASEM (GB), 1 race at 3 years, from only 2 starts; dam of **MAGICAL MEMORY (IRE)**, 8 races at 2 to 5 years including Duke of York Clipper Logistics Stakes, York, **Gr.2**, third in Belfred Sprint Cup, Haydock Park, **Gr.1**.
