TASLEET (GB) (2013 c. by Showcasing (GB)), won 4 races at 2 and 3 years, 2016 and £245,059 including Greenham Stakes, Chelmsford City, **Gr.3** and Compton Estates Rose Bowl Stakes, Newbury, **L.**, placed 3 times including second in Richmond Stakes, Goodwood, **Gr.2** and Somerville Tattersall Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.3**, all his starts.
