**Cock of The North (GB)** (2012 g. by Cockney Rebel (IRE)), won 1 race at 2 years and £23,079 and placed 3 times including second in Cantor Fitzgerald National Stakes, Sandown Park, **L.** and third in 666bet Superlative Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.2**, died at 4.

**Dr Red Eye (GB)** (2008 g. by Dr Fong (IRE)), won 8 races and £71,723 and placed 28 times including third in Raymond Corbett Memorial City Plate, Chester, **L.**

**Kumbeshwar (GB)** (2007 g. by Doyen (IRE)), won 10 races and £190,169, under both rules and placed 27 times including second in AES Champion 4yo Hurdle, Punchestown, Tingle Creek Chase, Sandown Park, Matalan Anniversary Juvenile Hurdle, Aintree, Lightning Novices' Chase, Doncaster, Totepool Noel Novices' Chase, Ascot, Fred Winter Juvenile Handicap Hurdle, Cheltenham and Desert Orchid Chase, Kempton Park.

**TAIKI FRAGRANCE (USA)**, winner in Japan; dam of **APOLLO TIARA (JPN)**, won Fairy Stakes, Nakayama, **L.**; grandam of **JO STRICTLY (JPN)**, won New Zealand Trophy, Nakayama, **Gr.2**.

The next dam **SPARKALARK (USA)**, won 2 races at 2 years in U.S.A. including Sorority Stakes, Monmouth Park, **Gr.1**, placed twice including second in Schuylerville Stakes, Saratoga, **Gr.2**. Own sister to **NOSE FOR MONEY (USA)** and **Lizard Point (USA)**;

dam of **seven winners** from 8 runners and 8 foals of racing age including-

**SPARK OF LIFE (USA)**, won 6 races at 4 years in U.S.A. including Ladies Handicap, Aqueduct, **Gr.1** and Chrysanthemum Handicap, Laurel, **Gr.3**; dam of winners.
