CAMP FIRE (IRE), won 1 race at 2 years and placed once;

NEVER BE ENOUGH (GB) (2015 f. by Sir Percy (GB)), won 7 races at 4 and 5 years, 2020 at home and in U.S.A. and £136,624, under both rules including Kathryn Crosby Stakes, Del Mar, **R.** and placed 13 times including second in Robert J Frankel Stakes, Santa Anita, **Gr.3.**

Cock of The North (GB) (2012 g. by Cockney Rebel (IRE)), won 1 race at 2 years and £23,079 and placed 3 times viz second in National Stakes, Sandown Park, **L.**, third in Superlative Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.2** and fourth in Solario Stakes, Sandown Park, **Gr.3**, died at 4 years.

Dr Red Eye (GB) (2008 g. by Dr Fong (USA)), won 8 races and £71,723 and placed 28 times including third in City Plate, Chester, **L.**
