PERSIAN SONG (GB), ran a few times at 2 years; Own sister to BOLD ARRANGEMENT;

dam of four winners from 5 runners and 5 foals of racing age-

Mountain Song (GB) (1995 c. by Tirol), won 4 races at 2 and 3 years and £52,295, placed 5 times including second in Solaglas Winter Hill Stakes, Windsor, Gr.3 and third in Aga Khan Studs National Stakes, Curragh, Gr.1, from only 11 starts; also placed once in U.A.E. at 4 years, his only start.

Raindancing (IRE) (1994 f. by Tirol), won 1 race at 2 years and £11,242, placed 5 times including third in Princess Margaret Stakes, Ascot, Gr.3 and Milcars Masaka Stakes, Kempton Park, L.; dam of a winner.

Jack Spratt (IRE) (c. by So Factual (USA)), 3 races at 2 years, 2000 and placed twice; also placed once in France viz second in Criterium de Vitesse, Chantilly, L.

ZAGALETA (GB) (1997 f. by Sri Pekan (USA)), won 2 races at 3 and 4 years, 2001 and £14,438 and placed 8 times.

ZANDEED (IRE) (1998 g. by Inchinor (GB)), won 4 races consecutively, £13,738 at 3 years, 2001.
