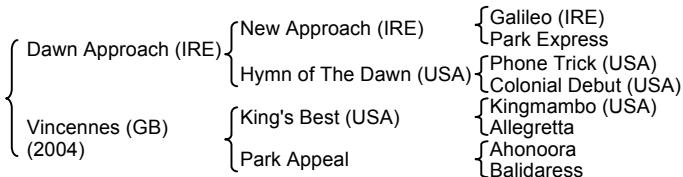

Halimi (IRE) (2016 g. by Teofilo (IRE)), won 4 races at 3 and 4 years, 2020 and £152,073 and placed 12 times including third in Dubai Millennium Stakes, Meydan, **Gr.3** and Devoy Stakes, Naas, **L.**, also fourth in Dubai Racing Club Classic, Meydan, **L.**

VALKO (GB) (2013 g. by Oasis Dream (GB)), won 1 race at 2 years and placed twice.

Zynah (IRE) (2011 f. by Oasis Dream (GB)), placed once at 3 years; dam of 2 winners viz-

SEA WATCH (IRE), 3 races at 3 and 4 years, 2021 in France, £76,029, placed 3 times.

PARK APPEAL, Champion 2yr old filly in England and Ireland in 1984, won 5 races at 2 and 4 years at home and in U.S.A. and £106,918 including Cheveley Park Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.1**, Moyglare Stud Stakes, Curragh, **Gr.1**, Oldtown Stud Stakes, Phoenix Park, **L.** and Country Queen Stakes, Hollywood Park; Own sister to **NASHAMAA**;

dam of **nine winners** from 9 runners and 12 foals of racing age including-

CAPE CROSS (IRE) (c. by Green Desert (USA)), won 5 races and £266,105 including Lockinge Stakes, Newbury, **Gr.1**, Queen Anne Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.2**, Celebration Mile, Goodwood, **Gr.2**, third in Prix Jacques Le Marois, Deauville, **Gr.1**; champion sire.

GREAT BRITAIN (GB) (c. by Green Desert (USA)), won 2 races at 3 and 5 years at home and in U.A.E. and £77,175 including Land Rover Al Quoz Sprint, Nad Al Sheba, **L.**, placed 4 times including third in Wentworth Stakes, Windsor, **L.**, from only 7 starts; sire.

PHOENIX PARK (GB) (g. by Sadler's Wells (USA)), won 3 races at 4 and 6 years in France and £45,380 including Prix du Carrousel, ParisLongchamp, **L.**, placed 5 times.

Mansfield Park (GB) (f. by Green Desert (USA)), won 2 races at 2 and 3 years and £17,021, placed 3 times including third in Rosemary Stakes, Ascot, **L.**; dam of winners.

Lord of Appeal (GB) (c. by Sadler's Wells (USA)), won 1 race at 3 years in France and £15,929 and placed once viz second in Prix de Reux, Deauville, **L.**; sire.

PASTORALE (GB), won 2 races at 3 years; dam of winners.

IFFRAAJ (GB), 7 races and £375,547 including Lennox Stakes, Goodwood, **Gr.2**, Park Stakes, York, **Gr.2** (twice), second in July Cup, Newmarket, **Gr.1**; sire.

FARRAAJ (IRE), 6 races and £395,052 including Winter Derby, Lingfield Park, **Gr.3**, Churchill Stakes, Lingfield Park, **L.**, third in Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf (c&g), Churchill Downs, **Gr.1** and Longines LKS Mackinnon Stakes, Flemington, **Gr.1**.

KAREYMAH (GB), 3 races at 2 years at home and in France and £36,303 including Prix du Calvados, Deauville, **Gr.3** and Sweet Solera Stakes, Newmarket, **L.**

Tagdeyr (GB), 4 races at 3 and 4 years, third in Guisborough Stakes, Redcar, **L.**

JATHAABEH (GB), 2 races at 3 years and £22,600; dam of **MIJHAAR (GB)**, 2 races at 3 and 5 years and £68,455 including Braveheart Stakes, Hamilton Park, **L.**

ARVOLA (GB), won 1 race at 3 years and placed twice; dam of winners.

DIKTAT (GB), Champion older sprinter in Europe in 1999, 7 races at home and in France and £537,665 including Haydock Park Sprint Cup, Haydock Park, **Gr.1**, Prix Maurice de Gheest, Deauville, **Gr.1**, Jersey Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.3**, Criterion Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.3**, third in Prix du Moulin de Longchamp, Longchamp, **Gr.1**; sire.

RECITE (JPN), 1 race at 2 years; dam of **ONE SPIRIT (IRE)**, won Owenstown Stud Whitehead Memorial Stakes, Naas, **L.**, **Some Spirit (IRE)**, 1 race at 3 years and £22,323 and placed second in Fairy Bridge Stakes, Tipperary, **Gr.3**.

SHOEI MIZUKI (JPN), winner in Japan; dam of **Developpe (JPN)**, winner in Japan, second in Shion Stakes, Nakayama, **L.**; grandam of **CROCOSMIA (JPN)**, won Ireland Trophy Fuchu Himba Stakes, Tokyo, **Gr.2**, placed second in Queen Elizabeth II Cup, Kyoto, **Gr.1** (3 times) and third in Victoria Mile, Tokyo, **Gr.1**.
