POSTMAN (GB) (2006 g. by Dr Fong (USA)), won 2 races at 3 years, 2009 and £6,795 and placed 4 times.

GOOD FAITH (NZ), Champion 2yr old filly in New Zealand in 1996-97, won Ford Dealer Team Sires' Produce Stakes, Ellerslie, Gr.1; dam of TULLY DANE (AUS), won H D F McNeil Stakes, Caulfield, Gr.3 and placed third in Sky City Railway Stakes, Ellerslie, Gr.1; sire.

SPRING (NZ), winner in New Zealand; dam of DAFFODIL (NZ), Champion 3yr old filly in New Zealand in 2008-09, won Patinack Farm AJC Oaks, Randwick, Gr.1, New Zealand Bloodstock 1000 Guineas, Riccarton Park, Gr.1 and Windsor Park Plate, Hastings, Gr.1.

Charlotte Dundas (GB), placed once at 3 years; dam of winners.

BAND GIPSY (USA), won Grande Premio Presidente da Republica, Gavea, Gr.1.

Shallop (GB), ran a few times at 2 and 3 years; dam of winners.

Sir Al (IRE), won 4 races at 3 and 4 years, 2010 in U.S.A. and placed 3 times including second in Hawthorne Derby, Hawthorne, Gr.3.

Laugharne, ran once at 2 years; dam of winners.

Power Lake (GB), winner at home and in Italy, placed second in Flying Childers Stakes, Doncaster, Gr.2.
