BATTAASH (IRE) (2014 g. by Dark Angel (IRE)), Champion older sprinter in Europe in 2018, 2019 & 2020, won 13 races at 2 to 6 years at home and in France, £1,774,182 including Nunthorpe Stakes, York, **Gr.1** (twice), King's Stand Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.1**, Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp, Chantilly, **Gr.1**, King George Stakes, Goodwood, **Gr.2** (4 times), Temple Stakes, Haydock, **Gr.2** (twice), Coral Charge Sprint, Sandown, **Gr.3**, Scurry Stakes, Sandown, **L.**, placed 8 times including second in King's Stand Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.1** (twice), third in Cornwallis Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.3** and fourth in Nunthorpe Stakes, York, **Gr.1** (twice) and Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp, ParisLongchamp, **Gr.1**, also fourth in King's Stand Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.1**.
