STEED (GB) (2007 g. by Mujahid (USA)), won 9 races to 2016 at home and in Bahrain and £32,989 and placed 5 times.

FROISSEE (GB) (2004 f. by Polish Precedent (USA)), won 3 races at 3 and 4 years and £27,765 and placed 10 times.
