BOMAR (IRE) (2009 c. by Sir Percy (GB)), Champion 3yr old colt in Scandinavia in 2012, won 6 races at 2 and 3 years in Norway and in Sweden and £218,905 including Land Rover Svenskt Derby, Jagersro, **L.**, placed 7 times including second in Scandic Norsk Derby, Ovrevoll, **L.**, Bilgruppen 1 Lund SFK Jubileumsloppning, Jagersro, **L.** and Songline Classic, Taby, **L.** and fourth in IKC Fonder Stockholms Stora Pris, Taby, **Gr.3**.
